



USB Adapter for Ford Installation and Usage Instructions

- 1. Ensure ignition off, key removed.
- 2. Remove radio from dash as per usual.
- 3. Remove 40-way MOST connector from radio
- 4. Connect the Connects2 adapter to the provided 14- way Molex connector
- 5. Connect Connects2 40-Way MOST connector to radio and original car's harness. <u>It is</u> imperative that the car's harness is connected to the Connects2 harness as the last step.

Usage:

The adaptor simulates a CD changer, so you can select it via the CD changer button on the radio, or the stalk buttons (if fitted). You should leave approximately 10 - 15 seconds after plugging a device into the USB connector before attempting to select the adaptor via the CD changer selection button. Each disk is simulated by a specific folder on the USB device; each track is simulated by a file in that folder.

Controls:

Normal CD changer controls; see original radio manual. There will be some small changes (unsupported operations) compared to the original changer, such as the fact that shuffling (random) will random tracks within the current folder only, and repeat will not repeat a single track, only a disk.

USB Directory Structure

The directories on a USB device should be in the following order. Directories that do not follow this criterion will be ignored by the adaptor:

DISC1 DISC4
DISC2 DISC5
DISC3 DISC6

For best results, the number of files in each directory should not exceed 99.
